Neighborhood Greenway (Bicycle Boulevard) Design Workshop

The City of La Crosse is looking for public feedback on a neighborhood beautification and improvement! As part of the La Crosse Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan prepared in 2012, the planning process identified Avon Street for potential improvements that would make neighborhoods greener, more walkable, and more bicycle-friendly.

1 Open House

Displays boards summarizing traffic volume, speed, and crash data. Additional display boards will show neighborhood greenways implemented in other cities.

2 Visual Preference Survey

Breaks down neighborhood greenway treatments. Workshop participants are invited to review these treatments, vote for treatments they like, and identify potential locations for solutions. This process will demonstrate how neighborhood greenways can be implemented on a sliding scale depending on how much traffic speed or volume reductions would be needed.

3 Presentation and Interactive Discussion
