Notice is hereby given that the Board of Zoning Appeals will hear the following variance appeals in the 3rd floor conference room of City Hall, 400 La Crosse Street, at 7:00 p.m. on June 19, 2019:

<u>2622</u>	An appeal regarding the regulation limiting a residential yard shed to 120 square feet at 1219 Kane Street, La Crosse, Wisconsin.
<u>2623</u>	An appeal regarding the requirement that fill around the perimeter of a building shall not be less than one foot below the flood protection elevation and shall extend at least 15 feet beyond the limits of any structure at 710 George St., La Crosse, Wisconsin.
<u>2624</u>	An appeal regarding the regulation limiting a residential accessory structure to a maximum of 35 percent of the rear yard square footage at 727 22nd St. N., La Crosse, Wisconsin.
<u>2625</u>	An appeal regarding the requirement to provide a rear yard setback of 20 feet at 411 3rd St. S., La Crosse, Wisconsin.
<u>2626</u>	An appeal regarding the requirement to provide a 25 foot setback from the front property line at 1647 Charles St., La Crosse, Wisconsin.
