Subject: BECKY LAKOWSKE ANNEXATION

The proposed annexation submitted to our office on April 3, 2014, has been reviewed and found proper in the public interest. In determining whether an annexation is in the public interest, s. 66.0217 (6). Will Stats. requires the Department to examine "[t]he shape of the proposed annexation and the homogeneity of the territory with the annexing village or city and any other contiguous village or city...." so as unincorporated land transitions to city or village status, the resulting boundaries are rational and easy for jurisdictions and residents to follow.

The subject petition is for territory that is reasonably shaped and contiguous to the City of La Crosse as determined by *In re Annexation of Smith Property (2001 WI APP 201, 247 Wis.2d 946, 634 N.W.2d 840).* Also, the annexation is consistent with the *Stipulation and Intergovernmental Agreement Between the Town of Campbell and the City of La Crosse* (2004) which permits annexation of territory on Hiawatha Island, such as the Lakowske's lot.

The Department reminds clerks of annexing municipalities of the requirements of s. 66.0217 (9)(a), Wis. Stats., which states:

"The clerk of a city or village which has annexed shall file immediately with the secretary of state a certified copy of the ordinance, certificate and plat, and shall send one copy to each company that provides any utility service in the area that is annexed. The clerk shall record the ordinance with the register of deeds and file a signed copy of the ordinance with the clerk of any affected school district..."

State and federal aids based on population and equalized value may be significantly affected through failure to file with the Secretary of State. Please file a copy of your annexing ordinance, including a statement certifying the population of the annexed territory. Please also include the MBR number with your ordinance as this assists with record keeping. Your MBR number is: 13764
