WHEREAS, the City Planning Department has submitted a grant application to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to construct a bicycle and pedestrian facility from Riverside Park and traveling north through the former Mobil Oil/Patros properties, and;

WHEREAS, the City was awarded an Outdoor Recreation Aid Grant in the amount of \$183,649.40 to complete the project, and;
