1.02 ALDERMANIC DISTRICTS BOUNDARIES. All local elections
beginning January 1, 2016 shall be

(A) NUMBER OF ALDERMANIC
DISTRICTS. The City shall be divided into thirteen (13) Aldermanic

(B) BOUNDARIES. The Aldermanic Districts shall be bounded as follows:

PROPOSED 13 ALDERMANIC DISTRICTS (ADOPTED 13 COUNTY SUPERVI-

SORY DISTRICTS)
(1) FIRST DISTRICT.

North – City limits. East – Oak Street from Lauderdale

Place extended east to Interstate 90; along Interstate 90 to the westerly spur tracks of the Burlington Northern Railroad; south along the westerly spur tracks of the Burlington Northern Railroad to Gohres Street extended east to the said spur tracks.

West - City limits.
