

> **ORDINANCE NO.: 4949** AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 34-66 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding con-sumption of alcoholic beverages un-der the jurisdiction of the Board of Back Commissioners Park Commissioners. THE COMMON COUNCIL of the

City of La Crosse do ordain as fol-lows: SECTION I: Section 34-66 is Sec. 34-66. - Alcohol beverages.
(a) No person shall have in their (a) No person shall have in their possession, custody or control any alcohol beverages of any kind what-soever, in any within 1,000 feet of any City designated playground, public swimming areas, or on park property within 1,000 feet of any school building or play structures, except as provided in paragraphs (b), (c), (d) and (e). SECTION II: Should any portion of this section be declared unconstituthis section be declared unconstitu-tional or invalid by a court of com-petent jurisdiction, the remainder of this section shall not be affected.
