AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Planned Development District - General to the Planned Development District - Specific allowing for continued use as green space / park at 1901 7th St. S.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The ordinance would modify the existing planned development to allow for a 1.28-acre park for patients, visitors, and staff. The plans include a covered pavilion for performances, landscaping, signs, and playground equipment. The park is surrounded by the applicant's property and is intended to complement its services.

GENERAL LOCATION:

Area adjacent to Sims Place and private street south of the railroad tracks passing through Gundersen Health System as seen in attached <u>MAP 16-0891.</u>

RECOMMENDATION OF OTHER BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:



Planning staff recommends approval of this ordinance. The plan does not conflict with adjacent properties and meets all requirements of the municipal code.


