

Resolution re-appropriating funds for reimbursing the Parks and Recreation and Street Department Operating Budgets and for purchasing materials and work related to the final Washburn Neighborhood CIP Project at 6th and Market.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Washburn Neighborhood completed two major Capital Improvement projects in 2015 using Neighborhood CIP funds;

WHEREAS, the Washburn Neighborhood prioritized doing a beautification of the corner of 6th and Market Streets with any remaining funds;

WHEREAS, the most efficient way to complete this beautification project is for City staff to use existing contracts and materials;

WHEREAS, the contracts used for this work are paid for out of Parks and Recreation and Highway Department Operation Budgets;

WHEREAS, Washburn Neighborhood CIP funds should be used to reimburse Department Operating Budgets and to purchase replacement materials for above-stated work;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that \$23,842.88 previously appropriated by Resolution 15-0422 for the Washburn Neighborhood Lighting Project are hereby re-appropriated for use in the above-stated work;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the City Engineer and Finance Director are hereby authorized to effectuate this resolution in the best interest of the City.
