On behalf of the department, here is a formal response to the letter and materials dated October 27, 2016, addressed to the Office of the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (attached).

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is actively studying transportation solutions within the City of La Crosse and the region through the Coulee Region Transportation Study. At this point in the study, there is a strategy package that would intersect WIS 16 at 7th Street. If the said right of way were vacated with the proposed resolution, the cost and viability of one of the Coulee Region Transportation Study's strategy packages could be impacted. For this reason, the Department of Transportation has concerns with the City of La Crosse vacating the right of way at the La Crosse Street/WIS 16 and 7th Street intersection as described in the resolution.


RESOLUTION
