ORDINANCE NO.: 4983

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to create Section 115-347(8) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse allowing distilleries in the C-1 Local Business, C-2 Commercial, and C-3 Community Business zoning districts by a Conditional Use Permit.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 115-347(8) is hereby created to read as follows:

(8) Distilleries for the production and bottling of distilled beverages, which includes a tasting room, with an annual production of less than 1,000 barrels per year and no larger than 5,000 square feet shall be a conditional use in the Local Business, Community Business and Commercial Districts. The storage of all items or materials utilized for the production of distilled beverages shall be in enclosed buildings unless otherwise approved by the Common Council. Distilleries must meet all applicable requirements associated with any state and federal licenses. Review of these applications shall include, but not be limited to, the following; location of property, current use of property, building type, construction type and adherence to National Fire Protection Association and International Building Code requirements.

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
