Boulevard Trees in La Crosse

The City of La Crosse is proud to be a certified Tree City USA. Approximately 20,000 urban trees flourish in the city's parks and boulevards. La Crosse is recognized as a Bird City, which promotes urban tree habitat creation and protection.

Boulevard Tree Benefits

Reduction of heating and cooling costs

Improves air quality

CO2 Reduction

Storm water retention

Increases property value

Aesthetic appeal

As the City of La Crosse carries out boulevard tree planting in the spring, residents are invited to participate in the decision process. Trees may be chosen from the "Recommended Boulevard Trees" section of this brochure or residents may research their own trees of interest. Traits of a good boulevard tree are: strong wood and branching, thorn less, single trunk, adapt to compaction, salt spray, and disturbance.

Program Details

Interested in having a tree planted on your boulevard? Contact the City of La Crosse Forestry Department or submit the enrollment form on the following page. \$150 installation fee is due after boulevard assessment and prior to spring planting. Please note that you are not paying for the tree, but rather for the installation of the tree.

Ordinances 34-144 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code applies to all trees along the Blvd.
