## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

Amendment No. 2 dated February 1, 2017

The Agreement for Professional Services made as of October 31, 2013 between the City of La Crosse, WI (OWNER) and Ayres Associates Inc, 3433 Oakwood Hills Parkway, Eau Claire, WI 54701 (CONSULTANT) is hereby amended as set forth below.

ATTACHMENT A, SCOPE OF SERVICES, Subsection 1.13 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

1.13.1 It is understood that the City is providing full time on site observations, and the City will contact Ayres Associates when they are in need of services. The City can call Chris Silewski at 715.831.7715, to schedule a site visit. Ayres Associates will provide the following services during the construction Phase of the Eagle Watch Area:

- Shop Drawing Review-Ayres Associates will review the submitted shop drawings
  for conformance to plans and specifications, provide comments along with a
  recommendation and forward on to the City for final review and concurrence.
  City will return completed submittal to the DOT Project Manager. Provide shop
  drawing submittals directly to Ayres Associates in Eau Claire Wisconsin.
  Samples are to be submitted to Ayres Associates in Eau Claire Wisconsin.
  When practical, on site review of large samples such as boulders, seat stones, or
  colored concrete will be completed during a requested site visit.
- Attend Pre-Construction Meeting Ayres Associates will attend the preconstruction meeting for WisDOT's I-90 project which includes construction of the Eagle Watch Area (anticipated to be held March 2017).
- Provide on-call services for the City This effort is to aid the City in the review of
  the design intent, and corresponding construction observation on site as
  requested by the City. This will be considered spot inspection as directed by the
  City. If possible, the City is to provide a minimum 3-day notice to the contractor
  and Ayres Associates of the desired scheduled on-site meeting to address a
  unique application of material.

Services not included under this scope are as follows:

- Quantity measurements and take offs as needed for the DOT Project Manager to approve pay applications.
- Full time on-site inspection of work being performed by the contractor.
- Completion of materials records for project management.
- Completion of operational and maintenance manuals.
- No staking will be provided.

ATTACHMENT B, PERIOD OF SERVICE, Subsection 4.6 is deleted and replaced with the following:

4.6 The following items of work shall be completed and submitted to the OWNER by the indicated dates:

60% Level Plans Draft P.S. & E. Final P.S. & E. Construction letting April 1, 2014 June 1, 2016 August 1, 2016 December 13, 2016

2017 construction season - July 1, 2018

ATTACHMENT C, COMPENSATION AND PAYMENTS, Subsections 5.1.1.1, 5.1.1.2 and 5.1.1.3 are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

- 5.1.1.1 CONSULTANT's Services. A Lump Sum amount of \$93,597.00
- 5.1.1.2 An amount equal to CONSULTANT's Direct Labor Costs times a factor of 3.0 for services of CONSULTANT's employees engaged directly on the Project, plus Reimbursable Expenses and charges of CONSULTANT's independent professional associates and subconsultants, if any.
- 5.1.1.3 CONSULTANT's Reimbursable Expenses Schedule is attached to this Attachment C as Appendix 1.
- 5.1.1.3 Total Contract Amount. The maximum total contract amounts pursuant to paragraphs 5.1.1.1 and 5.1.1.2 is \$109,597.00 (comprised of a Lump Sum amount of \$93,597.00, and a Direct Labor Cost times a factor of 3.0 plus Reimbursable Expenses in the amount of up to \$16,000.00). This amount shall not be exceeded without a written amendment to this Agreement.
