- 4. Prior record of property maintenance and concerns about future quality/maintenance (13)
- 5. Available ideas do not fit the neighborhood (8)

Provisions for Acceptance of Olson Petition

- 1. Create a more specific plan that is consistent with the R-1 designation in the comprehensive plan.

- plan that reflects neighborhood character
