

Dedication date is set for November 11th, 2017, "Veterans Day"

WW I Soldier Statue: Is being manufactured by DWO Fiberglass, Owner David Oswald, address P.O. Box 292 - 937 Industrial Drive, Sparta, Wisconsin, 54656

Construction material: All fiberglass material WW soldier statue, 6 feet 4 inches, plus a 1 foot fiber glass base (35 inch square) totaling 7 ft. 4 inches. Epoxy paint and colors will be used, plus part of the paint will be in the fiber glass. It will have 3 coats of epoxy clear coat. Life expectancy at least 100 years and it comes with a guarantee from any possible problems for the next 25 years.

The statue will rest on a brick or stone base, 3 feet high and 35 inches by 35 inches.

Plates with writings will be imbedded on the sides, such as:

W W I MEMORIAL

"We are the dead. Shot days ago.

We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,

Loved and were loved; and now we lie

In Flanders fields'

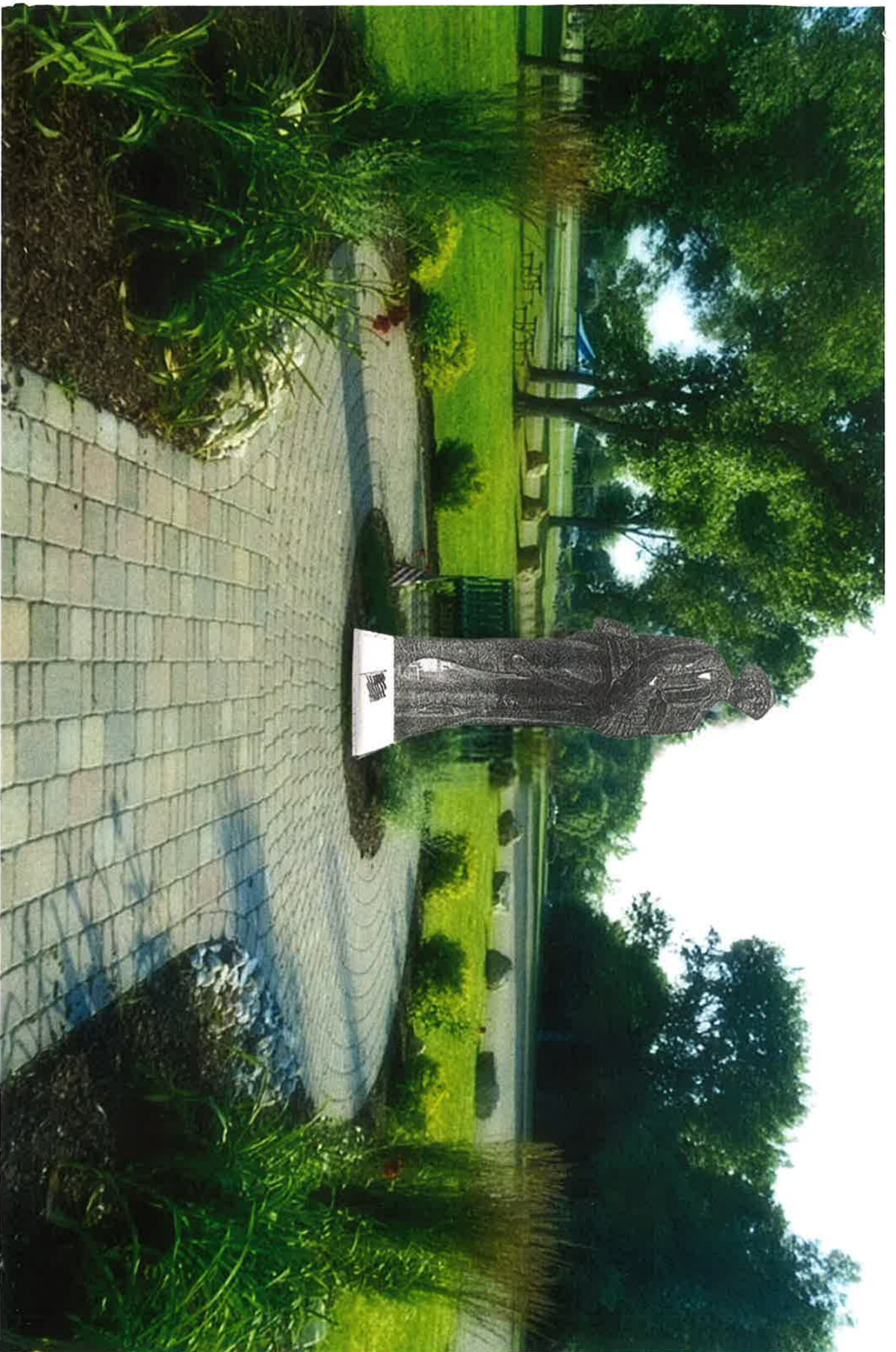
The total height of the structure will be 10 feet 4 inches.

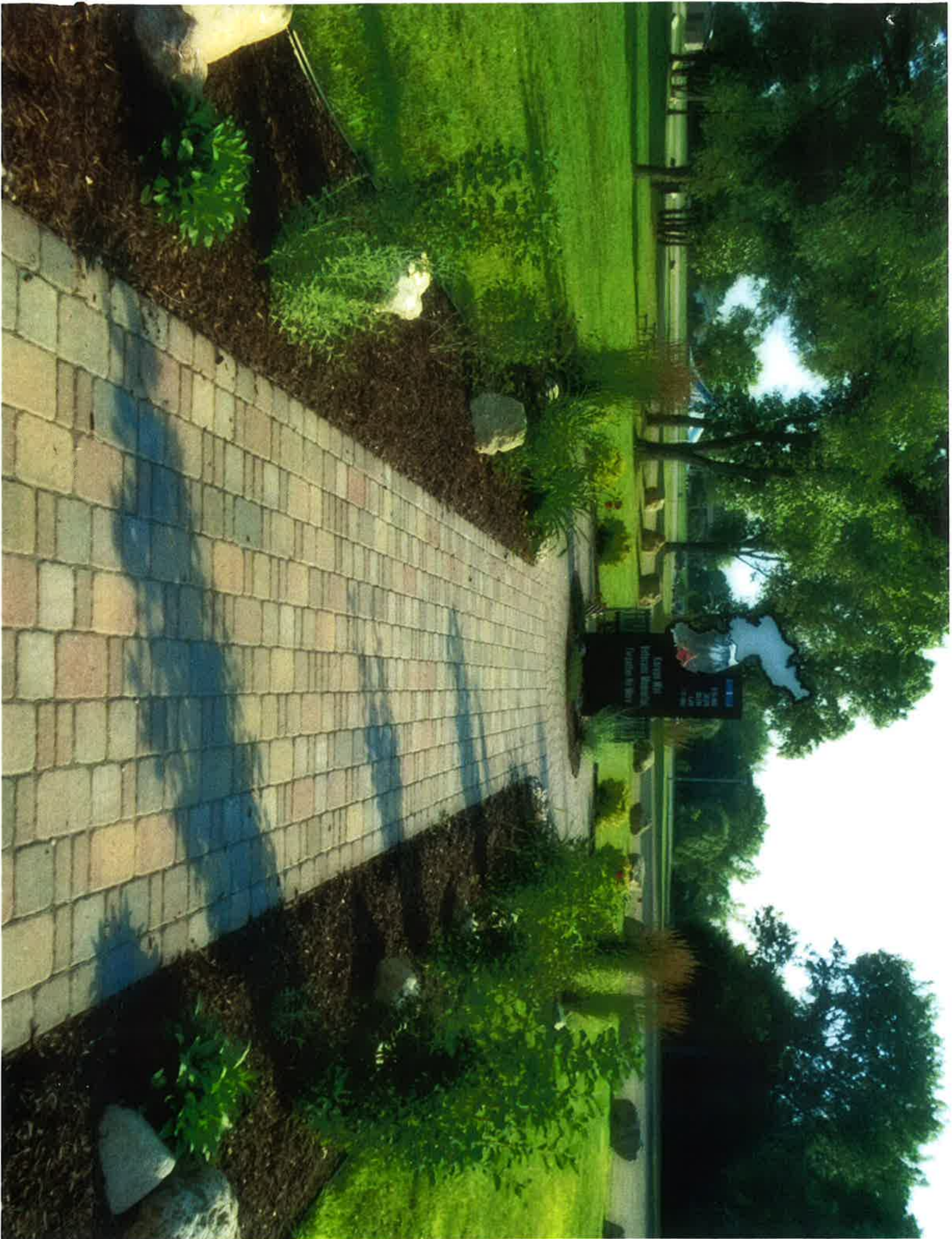
The Korean War Memorial turned out far greater than I hoped for, so most of it, paving and gardening, I'll copy. Why try to re-invent the wheel.
