ORDINANCE NO.: 5000 AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 22-23, 22-24(f)(1) and 22-24(f)(3) and (4) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding the Human Rights Commission

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as fol-

SECTION I: Section 22-23 is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 22-23. - City of La Crosse Human Rights Commission
The Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council, shall appoint a City of La Crosse Human Rights Commission, consisting of eight seven members, one of whom shall be designated Chair by the members of the Common Council. Members shall be a member of the Common Council. Members shall be of the entire City, and shall be committed to the principle of equal opportunities. They shall receive no compensation for their services.

SECTION II: Section 22-24(d) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d) Notice to respondent. Upon the filing of a complaint, the City Clerk Commission shall serve a copy thereof upon the respondent within 20 days of said filing.

SECTION III: Section 22-24(f)(1) is bereby amended to read as follows:

(1) Upon filing of the complaint, the City Clerk shall distribute a copy of the compliant to each commissioner. Within twenty (20) business days of the filing of the complaint, the commission shall determine probable, cause an independent probable cause. An independent fact finder, not a member of the Commission, designated by the Commission shall promptly investigate all duly filed complaints. Within 45 days of the filing of each complaint, said fact finder should issue

to the complainant, respondent and the Commission an initial determination in writing of whether probable cause, as defined in this article, exists, and setting forth the basis of The Commission the determination.
