ORDINANCE NO.: 5036

AN ORDINANCE to amend Sec. 4-47(a)(1) and 4-113 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding hours of sale for Class A alcohol licenses.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Sec. 4-47(a)(1) shall be amended to read as follows:

- (a) No premises shall be permitted to remain open for sale or consumption of liquor:
 - (1) If a retail "Class A" license, between 9:00 p.m. and 86:00 a.m.

SECTION II: Sec. 4-113 shall be amended to read as follows:

No fermented malt beverage shall be sold or consumed upon licensed premises between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Monday through Friday and 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, except that on January 1 the premises may remain open, provided, however, no fermented malt beverage shall be sold, dispensed, given away, or furnished directly or indirectly to any underage person. Between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. no person may sell fermented malt beverages on Class "B" licensed premises in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises. Class "A" premises may remain open for the conduct of their regular business, but may not sell fermented malt beverages between 12:00 midnight and 86:00 a.m.

SECTION III: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication.
