

Dear Park Board Commissioners,

I am writing to request the privilege of presenting a proposal to expand the disc golf course in Pettibone Park. I do so on behalf of the 7 Rivers Disc Golf Club Board of Directors, of which I am President. Our club is made up of 100+ members that are passionate about disc golf not only as an activity but also as a community. I appreciate your consideration. Below is a description of our proposal and efforts thus far.

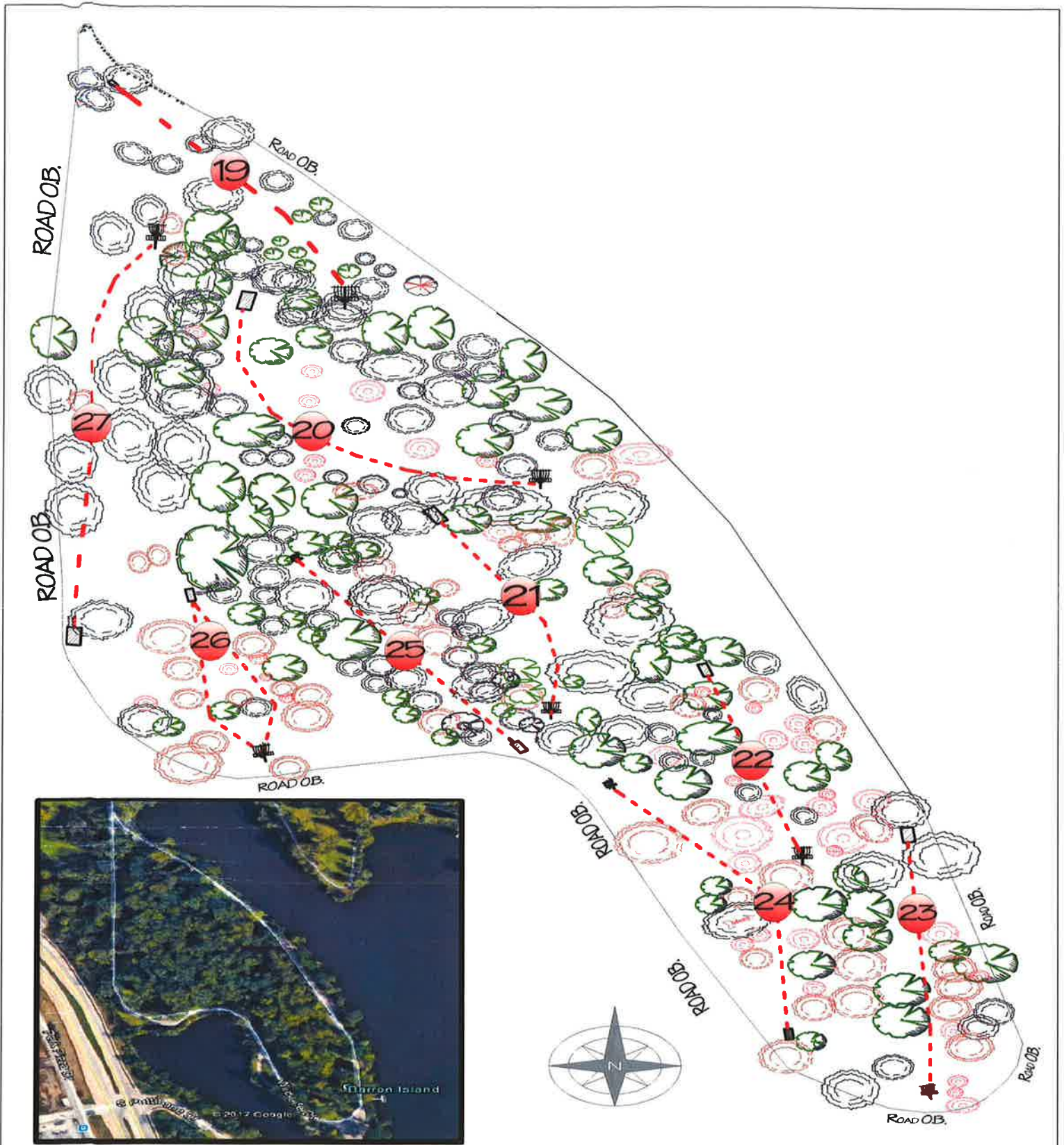
Our goal, put succinctly, is to gently develop and activate a severely underutilized section of the park (being the section surrounded by Wildlife Drive as it appears on google maps) while expanding the existing disc golf course. Please consider the following list of our efforts thus far:

- We have fundraised the adequate funds to purchase 10 disc golf baskets. One to replace the severely damaged practice baskets and 9 to install on 9 new holes.
- David James, one of our board members who has a degree in Horticulture Design, has drafted maps that layout all 9 new holes. These maps are included on the email sent with this letter.
- Through the winter months we plan to continue fundraising for tee pads for the new 9 holes. Given our success in raising the money for baskets, we are confident this will not be beyond our ability.
- We have secured an agreement with a private course in eastern Wisconsin to purchase gently used baskets of the same make as what is currently at Pettibone for \$2500. We have fundraised more than enough capital to cover that cost. The baskets to be purchased are less than 7 years old and in perfect working order.

Our goal is to complete this project and any future improvements with the blessing of the Park and Recreation Department and Parks Board and at no cost to the city. We consider it our responsibility to nurture and grow Pettibone park and disc golf course as the valuable resource it is. Disc golf enthusiasts both in our club and who are not cherish this course as a recreational sanctuary and an exercise/training facility. Thank you so much in advance for considering our proposal.

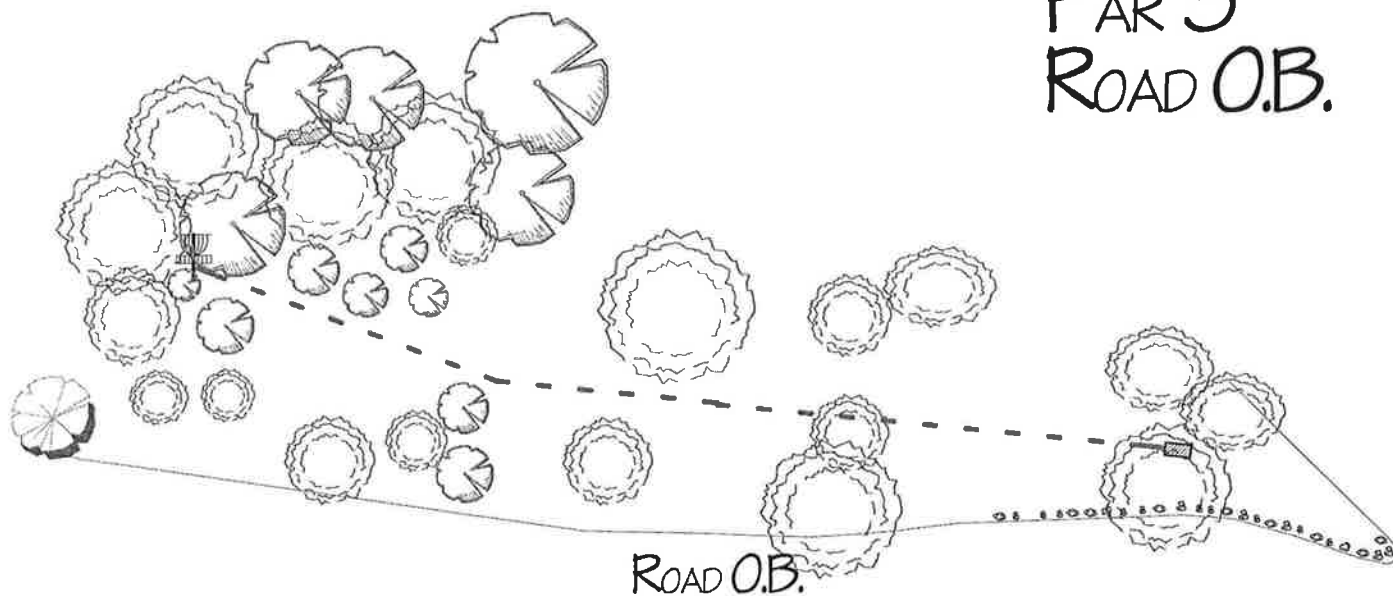
