AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by adding thereto new territory and making additions and corrections to the zoning map (Medary & Shelby City-owned parcels).

▶ BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The subject parcels, depicted on attached <u>MAPs PC17-1130</u> were approved for annexation to the City of La Crosse by the Common Council in July 2015. These parcels were acquired through the Bluffland Preservation Program. There are 28 parcels that were located in the Town of Medary and 9 parcels that were located in the Town of Shelby. Typically the land acquired through this program is annexed to the City.

The approval of a zoning district/designation completes the annexation process. The proposed zoning district for all of these parcels is Conservancy which is consistent with all of the parcels that have been acquired through the program.


The Common Council approved the Ordinance for annexation at their July 2015 Meeting.

Having these parcels in the City supports the Natural Resource Objectives 3: Protect Wetlands and 4: Protect Wooded Bluffs, and Land Use Objective 11: Resource Protection.

This Ordinance is recommended for approval.








