AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by adding thereto new territory and making additions and corrections to the zoning map (608 Dakota St. - City-owned parcel).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The subject parcel, depicted on attached <u>MAP PC17-1132</u>, was approved for annexation to the City of La Crosse by the Common Council in June 2016. This parcel was identified in the Airport's Master Plan to be purchased by the La Crosse Regional Airport for runway protection. The existing structure was approved by the Common Council to be removed by Conditional Use Permit in August 2016.

The approval of a zoning district/designation completes the annexation process. The proposed zoning district is Public/Semi-Public to be consistent with the zoning of the airport.

GENERAL LOCATION:

608 Dakota Street. (French Island)

RECOMMENDATION OF OTHER BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:


The Common Council approved the Ordinance for annexation at their June 2016 Meeting.

CONSISTENCY WITH ADOPTED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:

This Ordinance is consistent with the adopted comprehensive plan. While the Future Land Use Map has identified the parcel as single family housing, the action for Objective 13 of the Transportation Plan Element says, "The City should work to implement the recommendations of the *Airport Master Plan*. This will include addressing land use issues related to airport noise impacts and safety issues."
