Attached are 2 items that I would like you to consider when making your decision tomorrow regarding the future of the Memorial Pool and item #17-1608 for the City Council Meeting.

- 1. Veterans Memorial Pool costing research demonstrating why the approved 2018-2022 CIP Budget amount of \$3.99m is an appropriate figure for the pool renovation.
- 2. A potential costing example (not to be used as a specification), utilizing various concepts to date, that I believe would meet the Historic Preservation Commission and resident needs for \$3.91million.

Additionally, given that there has been sufficient preliminary design, public input and discussion on this item, it is timely to turn the information to date over to the appropriate team of staff to develop a request for proposals for the architecture and engineering of the facility in order to begin construction in 2018.
