Police Department Monthly Report

In the News

On January 9th, Chief Tischer and the Washburn Neighborhood Resource Officers were presented with a significant donation from our partners at Mayo Clinic Health System – Franciscan Healthcare. The \$75,000 donation was given to ensure that the NROs remain in the Washburn neighborhood.

On January 12th, State Bank of La Crosse presented the La Crosse Police Department with a donation from the annual Chili Cook Off fundraiser. The donation is used for the D.A.R.E. program in La Crosse schools.

On January 15th, as part of a burglary investigation, Investigators and members of the Emergency Response Team served a search warrant at 1018 Gillette St. Several individuals in the home tried to escape through a basement window. After some “encouragement” from Police K-9 Zeus, they remained in the basement and were taken into custody. Besides all the TVs, video game systems, computers, and other electronic items, Investigators seized a loaded hand gun and a wide array of illegal drugs including 336.7 grams of Ecstasy, 137.5 grams of cocaine, 37.7 grams of crack cocaine, 26.7 grams of marijuana, 10.3 grams of heroin, 3.8 grams of fentanyl, and 50.5 grams of drug-laced sugar candies. Based on the current street price of those drugs, the estimated value was about \$57,000.00. Six individuals were taken into custody as part of the investigation.

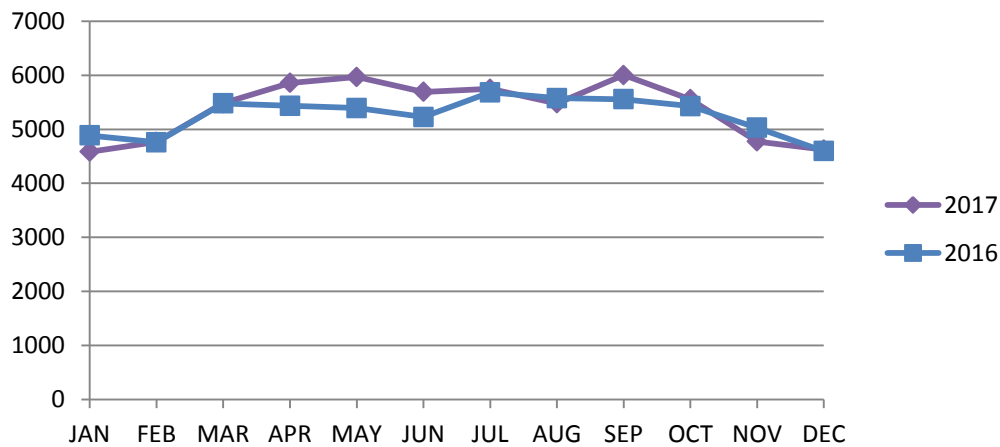

2017 YEAR END TOTALS



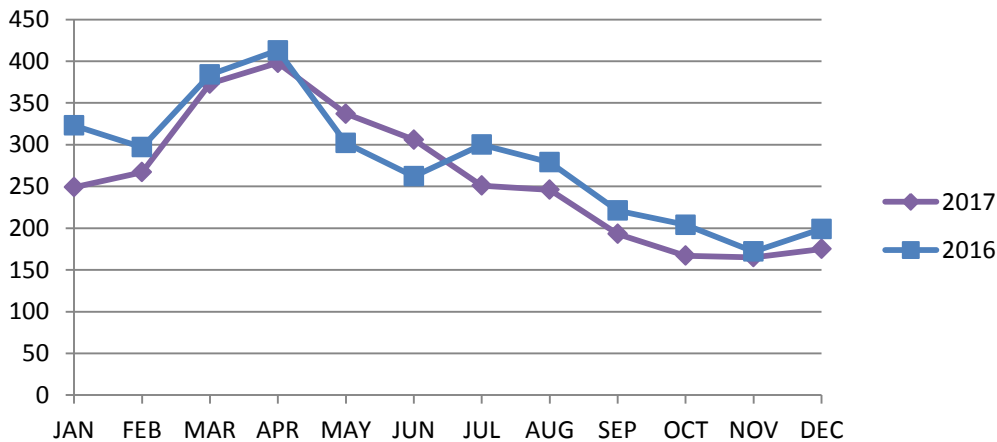
