- By 2025, the City will reduce overall energy consumption as measured per square foot within City facilities from 2007 by a minimum of 25%.
  (23,242,915 kWh; 428,119 therms in 2007)
- By 2025, at least 25% of the City's energy needs in City facilities will be generated from renewable resources.
- The City will consider LEED equivalent ratings in all major renovation projects and new City buildings.
- By 2025, the City will consume at least 25% less fossil fuel for its
  transportation fleet. (262,371 gal of diesel; 134,720 gal of gas in 2007)
- By 2025, at least 25% of the fuel consumed for the City's fleet will come
  from renewable sources and alternative fuels.
- City will consider policies to reduce the amount of fossil fuel used by employees in order to get to and from work.
- The City will enhance our community's transportation system.
- By 2025, at least 25% of the City's residents' energy needs will be generated from renewable resources.
