RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there exists within the City of La Crosse a need for blight elimination, slum clearance, and urban renewal programs and projects, and

WHEREAS, such blight elimination, slum clearance, and urban renewal programs and projects will constitute a more effective means of elimination of substandard, deteriorating, deteriorated, insanitary, slum and blighted areas, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to create a Redevelopment Authority to be known as the Redevelopment Authority of La Crosse, for the purpose of carrying out blight elimination, slum clearance, and urban renewal programs and projects as permitted by statute, together with all powers necessary or incidental to effect adequate and comprehensive blight elimination and slum clearance and urban renewal programs and projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it is hereby declared that there exists within the City of La Crosse a need for blight elimination, slum clearance and urban renewal programs and projects, and upon adoption of this resolution and upon a certified copy of same being transmitted to the Mayor, there is hereby created a Redevelopment Authority, which Authority shall consist of seven (7) resident freeholders as commissioners of the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commissioners who are first appointed shall be designated by the Mayor to serve the following terms: two for one year, two for two years, one for three years, one for four years, and one for five years, from the date of their appointment; thereafter the term of office shall be for five years. A commissioner shall hold his office until a successor has been appointed and qualified. No more

than two of such commissioners shall be officers of the City, and at least one shall be an alderman who shall serve ex officio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon appointment of such commission, they are hereby authorized to exercise the powers found in Section 66.431 of the Wisconsin Statutes, known as the blight elimination and slum clearance act, and any and all other statutes applicable thereto.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council on August 9, 1962 adopted the attached resolution providing for the creation of the Redevelopment Authority of the City of La Crosse, and

WHEREAS, current Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.431(3) providing for the establishment of Redevelopment Authorities provides for the appointment of seven (7) residents of the City as Commissioners of the Authority and does not require that the same be "freeholders", and

WHEREAS, Section 66.431(3), Wis. Stats., further provides that one (1) of such seven (7) Commissioners shall be a member of the local legislative body and not serving on the Commission as ex officio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA CROSSE that the August 9, 1962 resolution of the Common Council be amended to provide that the Redevelopment Authority of the City of La Crosse shall consist of seven (7) residents of the City as Commissioners of the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aforesaid August 9, 1962 resolution be further amended to provide that one of such seven (7) Commissioners shall be a Council member who shall serve on the Commission with full powers and duties, including voting rights and not as ex officio.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in all other respects the aforesaid August 9, 1962 resolution shall remain in full force and effect except as otherwise amended herein.
