The City of La Crosse will connect you with a qualified contractor to evaluate your home's insulation levels, heating and cooling equipment, ductwork, and more.

Receive a custom energy report

After your assessment, you'll get a full report outlining the most cost-effective ways to increase the comfort and energy efficiency of your home and available incentives to help make the improvements more affordable.

Complete home improvements and access incentives of up to \$4,100

The City of La Crosse will be with you every step of the way, from reviewing recommendations to coordinating installation, on through the incentive process.

Save energy, improve your home

For a limited time, during the Mayor's Home Energy Challenge, you can receive combined incentives from Focus on Energy, Xcel Energy, and the City of La Crosse. All together, these incentives may cover a large portion of your improvement costs.
