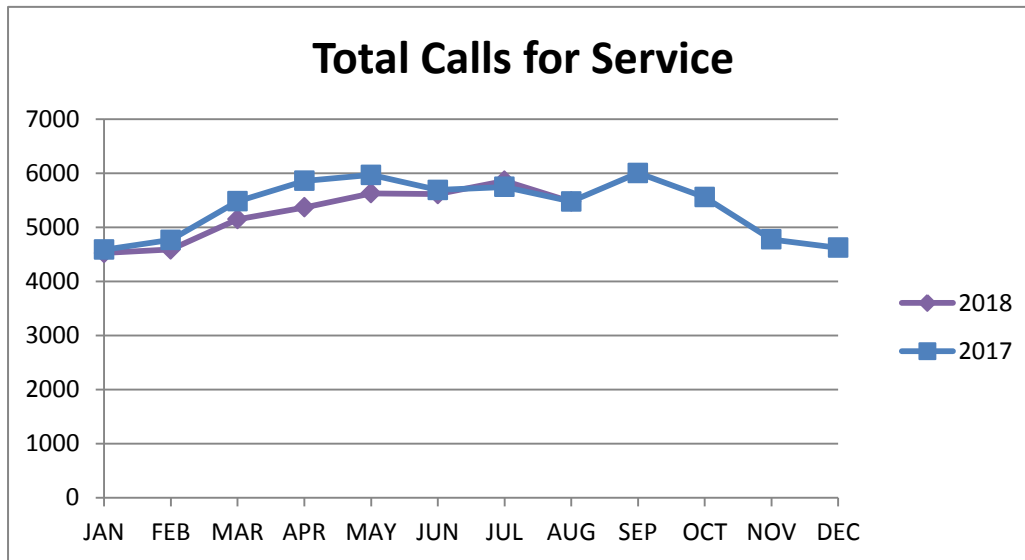

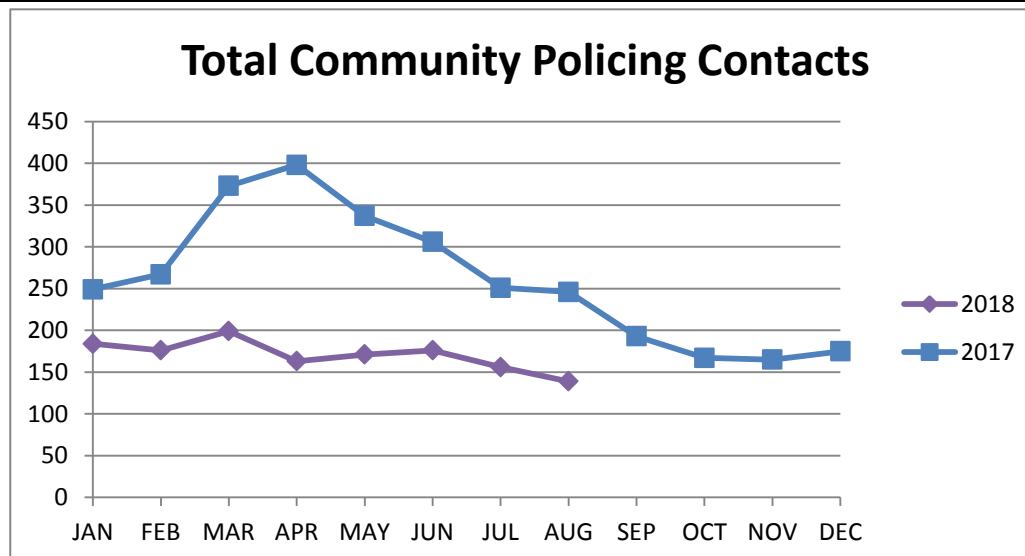
AUGUST 2018 YTD
