## Sec. 40-36. - Emergency excavations authorized.

In the event of an emergency, any person owning or controlling any sewer, water main, conduit or utility in or under any street and his agents or employees may take immediate proper emergency measures to remedy dangerous conditions for the protection of property, life, health, or safety without obtaining an excavation permit; provided that such person shall apply for an excavation permit not later than the end of the next succeeding business day and shall not make any permanent repairs without first obtaining an excavation permit hereunder. The Board of Public Works may require additional street surfacing removal and replacement for streets less than five years old and streets paved with Portland cement concrete.
