

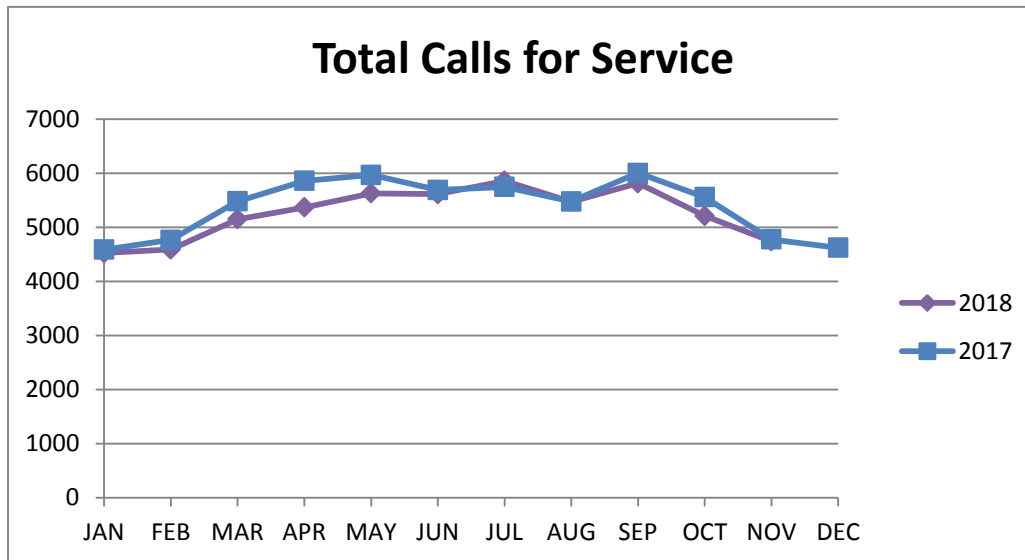

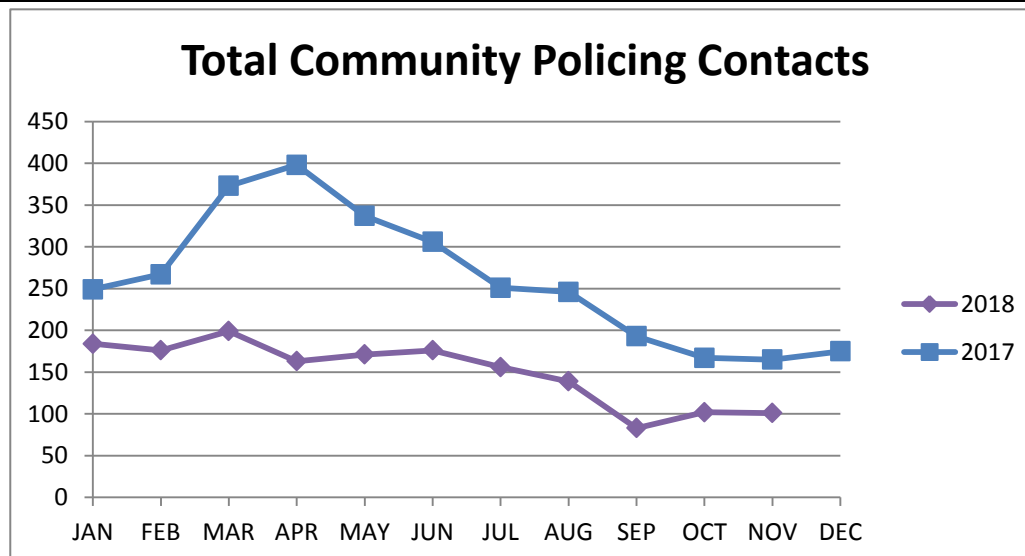
NOVEMBER 2018 YTD
