Resolution allocating additional Utility funding for the repair or replacement of utilities associated with 2019 Pavement Replacement Program Streets.

## **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, additional design and review of utilities under City streets programed for pavement replacement in 2019 have brought to light the need for utility infrastructure repair or replacement in these streets; and

WHEREAS, these needs were not known during preliminary review and CIP planning, thus funding was not allocated for these Utility repairs and replacements in the 2019 CIP budget; and

WHEREAS, there is a strong desire or need not to push these projects off until 2020.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Common Council of the City of La Crosse that additional Utility funding in the amount of \$555,000.00 be allocated for the performance of the following public work, to-wit:

Upsize to a 42" storm sewer main in 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Ferry to Cameron in the amount of \$325,000.00 from Storm Sewer Utility.

Add a new 30" storm sewer main in 22<sup>nd</sup> Street from Hyde to Green Bay in the amount of \$53,000.00 from Storm Sewer Utility.

Add a new 8" sanitary sewer main in Adams Street from 21st St to Dead-end East in the amount of \$21,000.00 from Sanitary Sewer Utility.

Replace a 8" sanitary sewer main in easement from new manhole by Mc Donald's to Ward Ave in the amount of \$14,000.00 Sanitary Sewer Utility.

Replace a 8" sanitary sewer main in 14<sup>th</sup> Street from State to Dead-end North in the amount of \$21,000.00 Sanitary Sewer Utility.

Replace and upsize a 18" storm sewer main in 14<sup>th</sup> Street from Alley south of State to Dead-end North in the amount of \$33,000.00 Storm Sewer Utility.

Replace 2 deep manholes located at and 28ft south of the Junction of Livingston and Avon Streets in the amount of \$53,000.00 Sanitary Sewer Utility.

Replace a deep manhole located 200ft south of the junction of 8th and Vine Streets in the amount of \$15,000.00 Sanitary Sewer Utility.

Add twin 2" communication conduits in Gillette Street from George St to Onalaska Ave in the amount of \$20,000.00 - \$10,000 from Storm Sewer Utility and \$10,000 Sanitary Sewer Utility.

BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED that the cost of these projects is hereby appropriated and ordered paid out of the following:

> Sanitary Sewer Utility \$134,000.00. Storm Water Utility \$421,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Public Works is hereby authorized to ensure that all projects enumerated and funded above are designed, bid, purchased and constructed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Public Works is authorized to prepare plans, specifications and estimates, advertise for bids, and report thereon to the Common Council for the above projects.
