Body Worn Camera Update

At the beginning of this year, Captain Dan Kloss, Field Services Bureau, audited the Department's Body Worn Camera program. So far, BWC users are at a 98% compliance rate for proper activation of BWCs during official police contacts. This is outstanding! BWCs have proven an effective tool for our department and officers, particularly when it comes to resolving frivolous complaints by reviewing footage. One example includes a complainant who came into the department to view footage as part of his formal complaint against an officer. Upon viewing, he realized that he was in fact in the wrong; he apologized profusely for his behavior and for "wasting Police Officer time". The Body Worn Camera program will continue to be an excellent tool for evidence capture, protecting officers from frivolous complaints, and providing transparency to our citizens.

On January 17th, Chief Tischer and Assistant Chief Abraham attended advocacy day at the State Capitol. They met with area legislators to discuss ways to improve and promote safety in the La Crosse community for both our citizens and our law enforcement personnel.



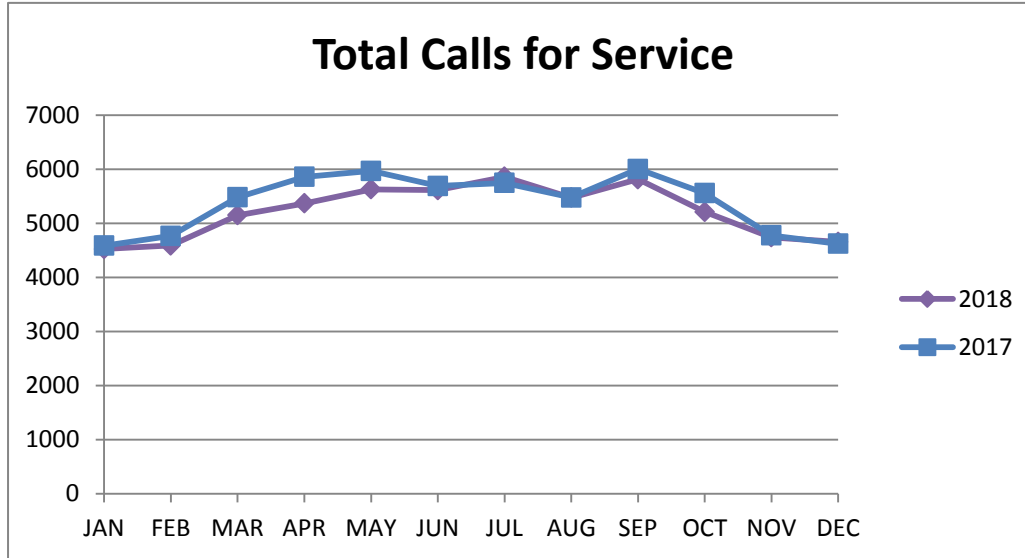

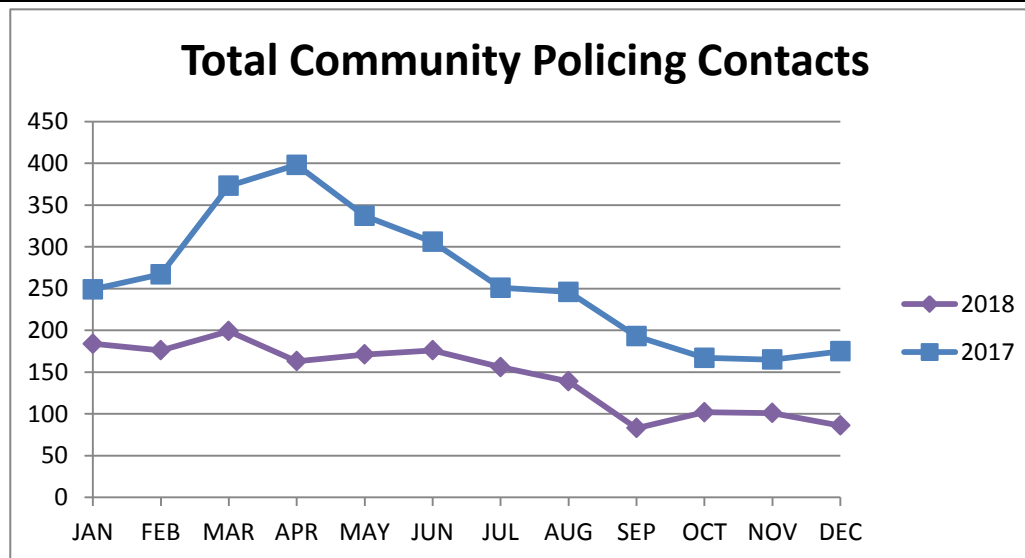
2018 Year End
