- 3. Providing annual objectives and metrics in improving the community's transportation choices
- 4. Increase bicycling and walking mode share in La Crosse by X% over the next XX years. <u>Current</u> modeshare numbers
- 5. Guiding the community to Gold League of American Bicyclists designation, and increasing modeshare X% bicycling and walking by X% by the year 2022.
