ORDINANCE NO.:
AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by changing the zoning for substantial portions of the City - comprehensive rezoning transferring certain property from Floodway District to the Conservancy District and Planned Development District.
WHEREAS, the Floodway Zoning District is determined by FEMA and does not adhere to parcel boundaries. The Floodway District should be removed as a base zoning district; however, will remain an overlay zoning district.
THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:
SECTION I: Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse is nereby amended by transferring certain property from the Floodway District to the Conservancy District and Planned Development District on the Master Zoning Map as follows:
See Comprehensive Rezoning Map
SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.
SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by changing the zoning for substantial portions of the City - comprehensive rezoning transferring certain property from Floodway District to the Conservancy District and Planned Development District.

Proposed rezoning is necessary because: The Floodway District is determined by FEMA and does not adhere to parcel boundaries. The Floodway District should be removed as a base zoning district; however, will remain an overlay zoning district.

Final action will be determined by the **Common Council** on **Thursday, March 14, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the City Clerk's Office.

The petition and/or maps relating to the above referenced amendment may be examined in the Office of the City Clerk, 2nd floor City Hall, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on any regular business day, holidays excepted, or in the Legislative Information Center which can be accessed from the City website at www.cityoflacrosse.org.


