- Re: Proposed Changes to Housing Rehabilitation Guidelines: Application Fee
 - Currently there is not an application fee for the Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program. It has been the experience of the Program that a significant amount of time is expended in processing the preapplication, the long application, site inspection, work write-up, soliciting and evaluating bids for the work, only to have the homeowner drop out.
 - It is the recommendation to require an application fee of **\$100** to be paid at the time of submission of the long application. The intent being to more accurately qualify the homeowner as to their commitment to project completion. The \$100 fee will be credited if the project does get completed, or the fee returned if the homeowner is determined ineligible at evaluation of the long application and supporting documents.
