ORDINANCE NO.: 5088

AN ORDINANCE to create Section 32-6 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding party to offenses.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 32-6 is hereby created to read as follows:

Sec. 32-6 - Party to Offense.

It shall be unlawful to be a party to an offense under this chapter. Whoever is a party in the commission of an offense may be charged with and convicted of the commission of the offense although the person did not directly commit it and although the person who directly committed it has not been convicted or has been convicted of some other degree of the violation or of some other offense based on the same act. A person is deemed to be a party in the commission of the offense if they directly commit the violation, intentionally aid and/or abets the commission of the violation or advises, hires, counsels or otherwise procures another to commit the offense.

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force effective upon passage and publication.
