## TSS/COD Compliance

- 1) Clean out sludge from EQ Tank to regain capacity and improve performance. (NO CHANGE)
  - a. The solids material in the EQ tank was tested and has now been approved by the landfill for disposal.
  - b. The cleaning out of the EQ Tank. We can't clean the EQ tank until the spring Of 2019, so we will not be able to install the tank recirculation system.
- 2) COD meter upgrade to monitor organic slug loads. Consider monitoring reactor pH. (In process)
  - a. The COD meter is on-site.
  - b. The meter is installed and Hach is schedule for 2/7 to install and start up.
- 3) Shipping all yeast offsite to reduce loading.
  - a. All yeast that is collected is being shipped offsite. Confirmed and no changes
- 4) Continued emphasis on in-plant control of slug loads.
  - a. A daily report is sent to all department heads and upper management on data metrics, targets and permit levels. Continuous
- 5) Investigate adjusting EQ operation to reduce impacts of slug loads. (Spring2019) Project was approved
  - a. This will be evaluated after sludge is removed and the existing piping inspected and mapped. (NO CHANGE)
- 1) East Reactor repairs (NO CHANGE)
  - a. . Stover was in in October for the inspection planning of the east reactor. Because of the EQ tank delay we are putting together a full scope for the inspection of the East reactor to be approximately October of 2019.

- 2) Request interim increase in monthly average pounds per day allocated mass capacity (May): DONE
  - a. The BPW approved increasing TSS to a monthly average of 8500#/day and increasing the term of the permit to September 2019.

  - a. Bypass Flow in operation DONE

- 1) Increased frequency of monitoring for Total Phosphorus. No Changes
  - a. Weekly testing in progress
- 2) Chemical inventory. Is Complete
  - a. The list of Chemicals in use is updated and verified with venders.
  - b. We have the Current SDS.
  - c. Under review. We have a Master Chemical List as part of our HACCP program and reviewing the data.
- 3) Review of nutrients added to reactor.
  - a. The phosphorus additions to the reactor were stopped. NO Change
