Campers will get an opportunity to learn about and spend time with animals we commonly see here as well as discover ways we can help as a community. Campers will learn how species adapt to extreme climates as well as conduct a science experiment that will help us better understand how the desert is so full of life! We will get to hold and analyze three different desert species of lizard, learning about the anatomy that is requires for this desolate region of the world. We also play a special "survival" game this day and the winners come out with a pretty neat prize!

Campers will have a fun filled day at Myric Park where we will seek out native amphibians and reptiles as we learn about their habitats and importance in the circle of life, right in our backyard!
