### HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION REPORT

**PROPOSAL:** The applicant is proposing to remove and re-install the bricks in the intersection at 20<sup>th</sup> and King Streets.

#### **PROPERTY OWNER:**

#### **APPLICANT:**

**BACKGROUND**: The HPC was given responsibility to review all exterior work that requires a permit from the City on Locally Designated Landmarks per Section 20-92 of the La Crosse Municipal Code. The Heritage Preservation Commission's decision is a recommendation/advisory only.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The applicant is proposing to carefully remove the bricks in the intersection of 20<sup>th</sup> Street S and King Street in order to construct bump-outs as part of the King Street greenway/bike blvd project and install a new storm sewer connection. After the new curb bump-outs are installed the applicant will be laying down a new base to re-install the bricks. Any bricks that need to be replaced will be replaced with the same type of street brick. Additionally, a temporary concrete strip will be constructed between the re-installed brick and the rest of the brick street on 20<sup>th</sup> Street S in order to hold the bricks in. The applicant has stated that it is not best practice to install new brick up to existing brick. These concrete strips will be in place until the rest of the brick street is redone.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

The applicant is removing some of the brick street for the new intersection design but will be reinstalling the remaining bricks back into the intersection and replacing any that are needed with the same brick that was removed from past brick streets in the City.

## **FINDING**

The proposed project will not have an adverse impact on the historic significance of the brick street. If anything, this effort will preserve one the few remaining brick streets left in the City and likely encourage the improvement of the rest of the brick street in the near future.
