Who We Are

The Veterans Memorial Pool Campaign (VMPC) is a group of community members working in partnership with the City of La Crosse to accomplish the renovation and reopening of the historic La Crosse Municipal Pool.



Our Mission

To invest in the health, safety, stability, and heritage of our community by ensuring Veterans Memorial Pool thrives as a 21st-century swimming facility welcoming to all ages and abilities.

Our Focus

In light of critical needs and competing projects, the City of La Crosse and the VMPC have formed a public-private partnership. The city has approved the design, allocated \$3.138 million in funding, awarded a construction contract, and begun construction with a scheduled completion date of June 2019.



Concurrent with the city's commitment, the VMPC is raising \$500,000 for construction, equipment and amenities necessary to complete the project.

The Once and Future Pool

In 1938, La Crosse citizens partnered with the Public Works Administration (PWA) to build and open our first community swimming pool located on the former La Crosse County Fairgrounds and ancestral land of the Ho-Chunk people.



The aging Memorial Pool closed in 2015, but the pool renovation is underway. It will reopen in 2019, once again connecting the community in the heart of La Crosse.



Post WWII, the pool was part of a vibrant hub for home building and commerce. Dedicated as "Memorial Pool" in 1948 to honor American veterans, the pool continued to serve generations of swimmers.
