Cherf: motion for File 2621 at 1402 Marco Drive, requesting a variance of seven feet to the required fifty foot setback. The unique property limitation is that it is situated between a dump and high water. There is no harm to the public interest in that there is no other neighboring structure and this serves the public and it is a facility that serves the public interest. The unnecessary hardship would be to greatly increase the cost and difficulty of the project because of the unstable ground of the dump.
