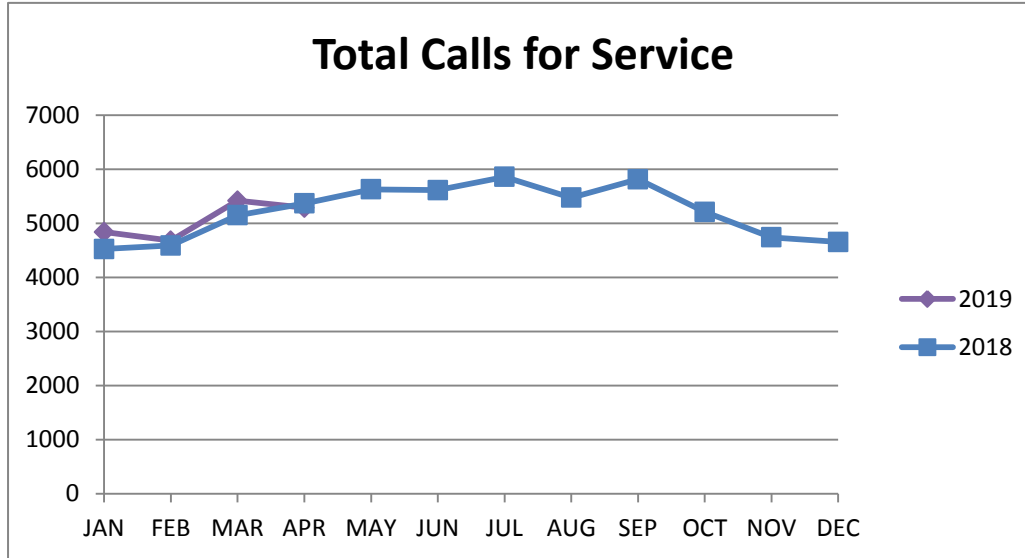

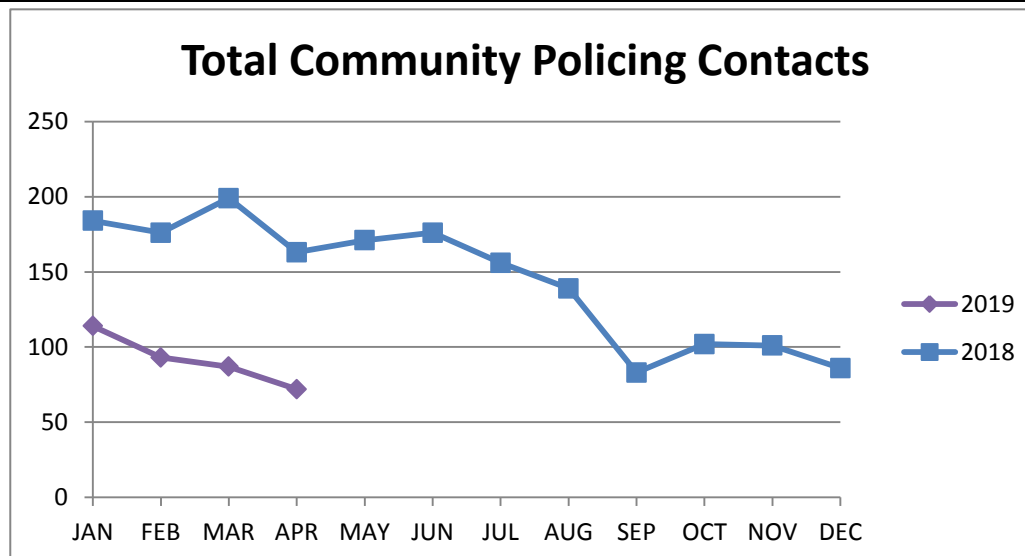
### APRIL 2019 YTD
