



Steve/Jason,

I told Will Hilton if 612 Winnebago wants to tie into the manhole we'd want him to core it at the invert and tie straight into that invert with a small section of straight pipe-then tie the lateral to that small section of pipe. We will not allow an inside drop. The manhole is brick and only 9.7ft deep. (see picture from Steve)

Will is talking about doing a pothole at the manhole and a pothole in the blvd and having Steiger directional boring the lateral. They would place the straight stub and tie into the straight stub all inside that trench box pothole. That's fine with the Utility.

PS - The alternate is to put in a full sewer main in Winnebago and assess him, or get a private easement from 801 6th street and put in a new lateral thru 801 that is just for 612 Winnebago alone. He doesn't like either.
