In the News

Each of the La Crosse Police K-9 Unit teams recently completed their annual recertification. Officer Dan Ulrich and K-9 recertified through the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms at the National Odor Recognition Testing (N.O.R.T.) certification at the Kohl Center in Madison. Officer Ulrich and K-9 Bill are certified in explosives detection. Officer Trent Bowe and K-9 Zaback, Officer Dakota Jelinski and K-9 Thor, Officer Steve Hughes and K-9 Zeus and Officer Aaron Westpfahl and K-9 Loki all recertified through the United States Police Canine Association (USPCA). These four teams are multi-purpose in that they are certified in narcotics detection, tracking, and apprehension.

Personnel

Lieutenant Tim O'Neill recently graduated from the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Command College. This six-week course, administered by the WI Department of Justice, aims to enhance leadership skills in Law Enforcement. Throughout the course, attendees cover a variety of topics and hone their skills in strategic planning, ethics, risk management, problem solving, and communication. The course culminates in a final project in which each attendee completes a study regarding an opportunity for growth within their department. Lt. O'Neill prepared a review of LCPD's move from a part-time victim services unit to a full-time, grand-funded Police Officer assigned specifically to victim services for the Police Department.




