In the News

In the early morning hours of July 28th, Officer patrolling downtown head a gunshot fired in the area of Who's on Third. Initial investigation found that an altercation had occurred outside between two suspects. During that incident, a third individual fired a single shot into the air and fled the area on foot. La Crosse Officers were able to utilize the Downtown SAFE-Cam system to capture the incident and a picture of the suspect, which was posted to our various social media outlets on July 29th. In just one day, Investigators were able to identify the suspect and he was arrested on July 30th. This is just one great example of the success of the SAFE-Cam system and our ability to work with the community to target crime.

On Tuesday, July 23rd, at the Wisconsin D.A.R.E. Officers Conference, La Crosse Officer Kurt Weaver was recognized as the 2019 D.A.R.E. Officer of the Year! 


JUNE 2019 YTD
