2017-2018 Council Priorities

- **Improve internal and external Communications**
 - Less emails and letter to property owners, and more 1 on 1 interactions
- **Improve community engagement**
 - Phone calls and/or in person engagement with residents
 - Drop off event "appliance and e-waste" at City Hall
 - Public Works Day open house
- **Improve public safety**
 - Ordering Immediate removal of hazardous materials & health concerns
 - Fishing line recycling containers at fishing locations to reduce from waterways
- **Improve code enforcement**
 - Door hangers for leaves in the street
 - Stickers for R&R carts in the right of way
 - Direct contact with property owners on violations
- **Improve streets and Infrastructure**
 - Using (crushed) recycled asphalt for road base in street projects
 - Purchase and use of an asphalt recycler to reuse old/left over asphalt for potholes or utility openings in the winter.
- **Improve public online access**
 - Recycler, citizen requests & leaf collection area map on webpage & Facebook

Department Accomplishments

- **2011-Installation of fishing line recycling bins. Miles of line has been recovered that is not polluting our waterways.**
- **2012-DNR awarded the Recycling Department the “Recycling Enforcement Leadership Award”.**
- **2015-DNR & AROW (Associated Recyclers of Wisconsin) awarded the Recycling Department the “Overall Program Excellence Award”.**
- **2016-Recycling Department increased recycling by 121% after initiating comingled automated refuse and recycling collection.**
- **2019-Recycling Department started hosting a “Summer Scrap It” event at City Hall, where people could drop off appliances and electronics for free.**
