TYPE OF ALTERATION: Removal of 2-Hour Parking

GENERAL LOCATION: 600 block 23rd Street North, West side

## Report:

A request, application, and petition were received to investigate the 600 block of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street North for 2-hour parking removal.

It is hereby noted that 60% of the footage is requesting removal of the 2-hour on the west side, but only 43% on the east side. It is recommended to approve the west side removal and refer the east side until all owners/occupants are in agreement. It is a reasonable possibility that if the west side is removed, the east side may follow suit shortly. It is therefore recommended to remove the 2-hour parking in the 600 block of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street N on the west side of the block.

WHEREAS, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

AND WHEREAS, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

Remove 2-hour parking in the 600 block of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street North as detailed above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
