AN ORDINANCE to create Section 4-153 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding Secondary Retail Sales for Brewers.
THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows: published, was inserted and published in the said newspaper on the SECTION I: Section 4-153 is hereby created to read as follows:
Sec. 4-153. — Secondary Retail Sales for Brewers. (a) Requirements for Secondary Retail Location for Brewers. (1) All sales of fermented malt beverages under this section shall be subject to zoning requirements under Chapter 115. 21st day of December 2019 under Chapter 115.

(2) No sales of fermented malt beverages under this section shall be permitted between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., Monday through Friday and 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

(3) Once the City Clerk is notified of a proposed Permit Extension or Secondary Location, the Clerk shall refer for appropriate review by La and thereafter on the following dates, to wit: refer for appropriate review by La Crosse County Health Department, Police Department, Fire Department -Fire Prevention and Building Safety, Planning, Development and As-sessment Department and Parks and Recreation, Forestry, Facilities and Grounds Department as necesbeing at least once in each week for sary. The Clerk shall provide com-ments to the Wisconsin Department successive week(s). of Revenue (4) All Brewers must obtain approval from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue in advance of any sales under this section.
(b) Indoor Secondary Retail Sales for Brewers.
(1) The structure must have suitable Tracy L Gerken exits and open spaces to accommodate anticipated attendance. It should contain adequate sanitary facilities to accommodate the size of the group.
