Bicycle – Pedestrian Maintenance Fund

Operational Concepts:

- 1. The City will be divided into three parts; La Crosse River Marsh north to city limit, La Crosse River Marsh to Green Bay St., Green Bay St. south to city limit.
- 2. Given past citizen requests 2020 will address central La Crosse.
- 3. Beginning in 2020 Staff will in October/ November rank each bicycle and pedestrian facility to be painted the following April/ May.
- 4. The list of ranking will be submitted for approval the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee.
- 5. Review of work will not consider pavement condition, potholes as that is beyond the scope of this funding.
- 6. Ranking will be based upon; current condition of paint (+1 best +5 worst), neighborhood and citizen requests (+1), facilities having deferred maintenance (-1), high traffic use (+1).
- 7. Projects that will be repaved/ reconstructed in the next year will be deferred until after completion of work.

Questions for policy makers and BPAC:

- 1. Should crosswalks be included? Or should that be included in other repainting?
- 2. Should we stipulate type of paint used? (epoxy = longer life)
- 3. Should we ask for a 2-3-year guarantee?
- 4. Does the committee want eliminate some existing sharrows?
- 5. Do we want to relocate sharrows to the center of the lane to avoid high wear zones?

Contract stipulations:

- 1. The City of La Crosse will not reimburse contractors for marking or signage that does not comply with the <u>Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices</u> (MUTCD), unless written request specifically requests deviation.
