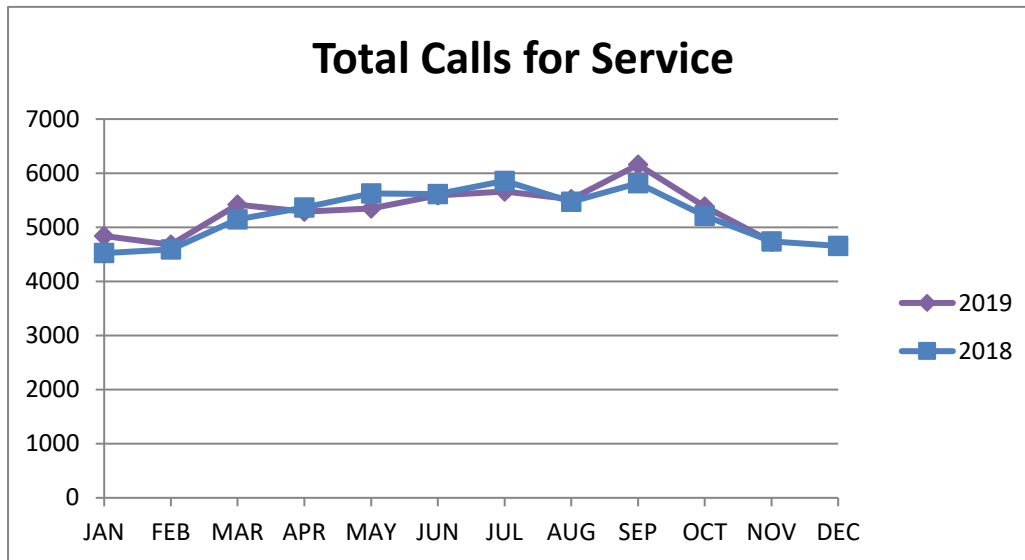

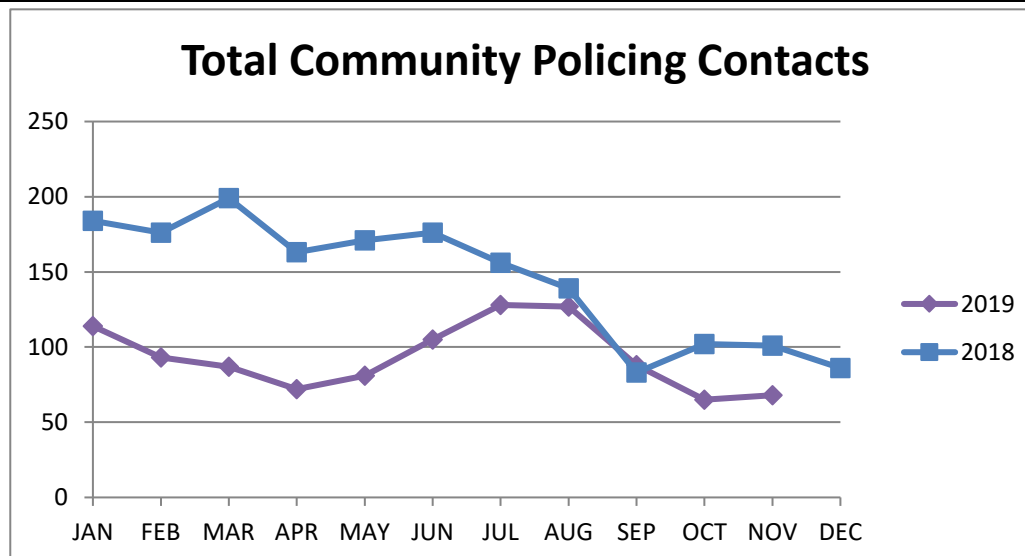
NOVEMBER 2019 YTD
