In the News:

January 1st, the La Crosse Fire Department was called to extinguish a detached, two-car garage fire. Within ten minutes, the fire was under control, leaving only moderate damage to part of the structure and no injuries reported.

January 8th, one employee was injured during a fire at Duratech Industries. When the La Crosse Fire Department arrived, the fire had already been extinguished by an employee and the sprinkler system. Fire crews assisted with securing the sprinkler system and monitored the area to make sure it was safe for employees to back to work.

January 11th, the La Crosse Fire Department responded to a structure fire on the City's south side. Residents had evacuated prior to the crew's arrival and nobody was injured. The fire had unfortunately spread from the home's first floor to the attic.















La Crosse Fire District Aggregated Map



La Crosse Fire District Heat Map




Public Assistance Calls—Needle Pickups





Community Risk Reduction (CRR) Week ran January 20th – January 26th. Community Risk Reduction is a collaborative, data-driven process to identify and prioritize local risks, followed by the integrated and strategic investment of emergency response and prevention resources to reduce their occurrence and impact.

On each day of this week, we informed the public (via social media) on one of the five E'ss of CRR – Education, Engineering, Enforcement, Economic Incentive, and Emergency Response – solicited feedback on risks in our community pertaining to fire safety and emergency medical services.


