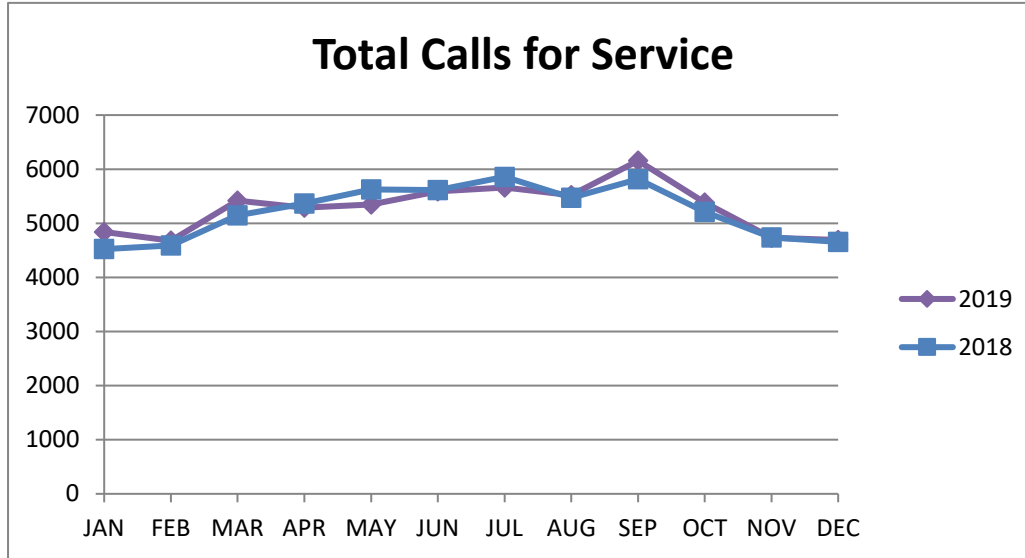

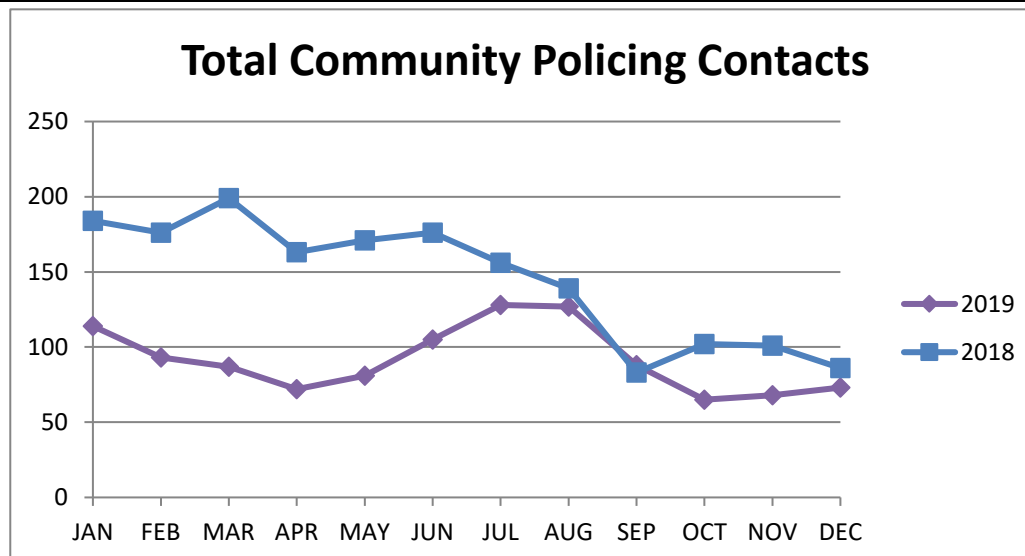
### 2019 YEAR END
