April 15th, firefighters responded to a building fire caused by an overheated dryer. The fire was extinguished quickly and no one was displaced or injured.

April 27th, firefighters responded to a garage fire caused by a spontaneous combustion of rags stored in a confined area. The garage sustained moderate fire and smoke damage, but thankfully, no injuries were reported.


